

## Academic Enrichment

UYA offers tutoring to students. Of students who participated in tutoring, 85% increased their academic performance.

- 99% of 9th graders promoted to 10th.
- 99% of 10th graders promoted to 11th.
- 98% of 11th graders promoted to 12th.
- 99% of 12th graders graduated.
- 322 hours of tutoring were provided.
